

Your Way to Heraeus Hanau

Arriving by car

Hanau is located east of Frankfurt and can be easily reached via the motorways from all directions.

Via A3 – coming from either west or east:

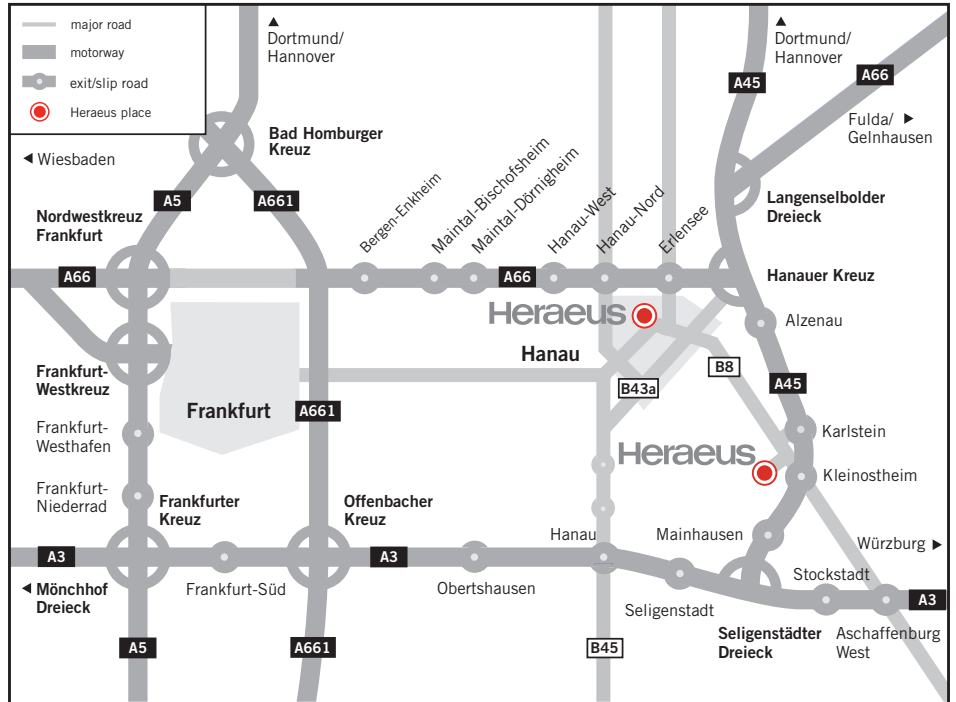
Take the exit Hanau and drive in the direction of Hanau on B45

Via A5 – coming from either north or south:

At the “Frankfurter Kreuz” (motorway junction), take the A3 in the direction of Würzburg. You’ll reach the exit Hanau after about 25 km. From there, follow B45 to Hanau.

Via A45 – approach from either north or south:

Coming from north, you’ll arrive at the “Langenselbolder Dreieck” (interchange). Here, get onto B8 and drive in the direction of Hanau to the sign “Stadtmitte” (city center). Coming from south, you’ll arrive at the “Hanauer Kreuz” (motorway junction), where you change to A66 towards Frankfurt. You can then take either the exit Erlensee onto B8, or the exit Hanau-Nord onto B45 in the direction of Hanau.



Coming by bus or train

Hanau is well connected to the pivotal ICE rail hubs in Frankfurt/Main, Würzburg and Fulda through tight regional rail, S-train, and bus networks.

From the Hauptbahnhof (Main Railroad Station) in Hanau, you can reach the Heraeus headquarters or Heraeus Quarzglas GmbH either by taxi or with the bus lines 2, 7 or 10.

For Heraeus Quarzglas GmbH in Quarzstraße, take any of the three bus lines and get off at “Dettinger Straße” (the first Stop). The entrance to the quartz glass plant is across the street from where the bus stops.

To get to the Heraeus headquarters, leave the bus at the “Stadtwerke” stop and walk about 150 m towards Kurt-Blaum-Platz (a big intersection). There, turn right into Heraeusstraße. After about 100 m, you’ll arrive at the main gate of the Heraeus headquarters.
